

ALDOPRIME 710 Rust Inhibitive Primer

DESCRIPTION:

AldoPrime 710 is a rust inhibitive primer. It is primer designed to be used on corroded metal substrates. This product can be applied as a primer for variety of roof coatings.

SUITABLE SUBSTRATES:

Metal

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTION:

SURFACE PREPARATION: The surface must be free of any oils, moisture, rust scale, soil or other contaminates that may interfere with good adhesion. Remove any loose material from seams or other surfaces with a wire brush or scraper. Oil and grease should also be removed with an appropriate cleaner. In many cases high pressure water blast will be sufficient to prepare the surface.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS: Apply only when ambient temperatures are 50°F and rising, and substrate temperatures do not exceed greater than 130°F. For best spray application, the product should be at a minimum of 60°F. Lower temperatures can be utilized for brush/rolling applications. When exceeding 24-wet mils or using dark colors, the likelihood of blistering increases.
