



ALDOTHANE 384 Polyurethane Elastomeric Coating

DESCRIPTION:

AldoThane 384 is a technologically advanced, high solids, single component, moisture cure polyurethane elastomeric coating. It has excellent adhesion properties to most conventional roof substrates. Once cured this liquid applied moisture-curing polymer provides a durable, seamless, flexible, waterproof membrane that resists lateral movement, shear and will allow for normal expansion and contraction.

- EPDM
- Aged TPO & Hypalon
- Aged PVC
- Modified Bitumen
- Metal
- BUR

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTION:

SURFACE PREPARATION: The surface must be free of any oils, moisture, rust scale, soil or other contaminates that may interfere with good adhesion. Remove any loose material from seams or other surfaces with a wire brush or scraper. Oil and grease should also be removed with an appropriate cleaner. In many cases high pressure water blast will be sufficient to prepare the surface.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS: Apply only when ambient temperatures are 50°F and rising, and substrate temperatures do not exceed greater than 130°F. For best spray application, the product should be at a minimum of 60°F. Lower temperatures can be utilized for brush/rolling applications. When exceeding 24-wet mils or using dark colors, the likelihood of blistering increases.

Store in a well ventilated place. Keep container tightly closed. Store locked up. Dispose of contents/container in accordance with local/national regulations.

STORAGE & HANDLING PROCEDURES:

Shelf life is 90-days if stored in original unopened containers. Store between 45°F and 95°F. Do not allow product to freeze. Do not heat with an open flame. All containers must be sealed when not in use. Wear protective gloves, protective clothing, eye protection, and face protection. If exposed or concerned: Get medical advice or attention. Clean equipment and any over-spray with water. A hand soap and water will clean hands.
