

CleanB4coat Cleaner/Degreaser

DESCRIPTION:

Inland CleanB4coat is a cleaner/degreaser used to properly prepare roofing membrane for coating. This is an alkaline, biodegradable, non-flammable cleaner and degreaser that uses alkaline builders, penetrants, emulsifiers and water conditioners to safely clean various roofing surfaces.

SUITABLE SUBSTRATES:

- EPDM
- PVC & Hypalon
- Aged TPO
- Concrete
- BUR Surfaces
- Granulated Modified Bitumen
- Metal
- New Spray Polyurethane Foams

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTION:

SURFACE PREPARATION: The surface must be free of any oils, moisture, rust scale, soil or other contaminants that may interfere with good adhesion. Remove any loose material from seams or other surfaces with a wire brush or scraper. Oil and grease should also be removed with an appropriate cleaner. In many cases high pressure water blast will be sufficient to prepare the surface.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS: Apply only when ambient temperatures are 50°F and rising, and substrate temperatures do not exceed greater than 130°F. For best spray application, the product should be at a minimum of 60°F. Lower temperatures can be utilized for brush/rolling applications.

Wear protective gloves, protective clothing, eye protection, and face protection. If exposed or concerned: Get medical advice or attention. Clean equipment and any over-spray with AldoThinner.
