

Fabric Polyester Reinforcing Fabric

DESCRIPTION:

Inland Fabric is a high-quality fabric utilized to reinforce seams, cracks, and roofing penetrations in tandem with various roof coating mastic and repair products. The stitch bonded fabric is a great option when wanting to reinforce many areas on a roof.

SUITABLE SUBSTRATES:

- EPDM
- PVC
- Hypalon
- TPO
- BUR (asphalt)
- Modified Bitumen
- Metal
- New Spray Polyurethane Foam

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS:

SURFACE PREPARATION: The surface must be free of any oils, moisture, rust scale, soil or other contaminants that may interfere with good adhesion. All previous repair material must be removed from seams or other surfaces. In many cases high pressure water blast will be sufficient to prepare the surface.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS: Apply only when ambient temperatures are 50°F and rising, and substrate temperatures do not exceed greater than 110°F. Apply coating at least 6 inches wide, centered over the seam or repair area. Then cut the desired length and immediately embed a 4 inch strip of fabric into the wet coating, ensuring it is centered over the seam. Use a dry bursh to work the fabric into the coating until fully saturated. Allow coating to dry to touch and apply a second layer of coating to fully encapsulate the fabric.

PRECAUTIONS:

- Fabric must be smooth, free of wrinkles and blisters.
- Fabric must be fully encapsulated.

HANDLING & STORAGE PROCEDURES:

Shelf life is 24-months if stored in original unopened containers. Store between 45°F and 95°F. Do not allow product to freeze. Do not heat with an open flame. Wear protective gloves, protective clothing, eye protection, and face protection.
